Energy Center Parent Handbook

1. Hours of Operation for the Energy Center are:

Monday – Friday 8:30am – 1:00pm & 3:30pm – 7:30pm**

Saturday 8:30am – 2:00pm

Sunday 10:00am – 1:00pm

If there are no reservations for 6:30pm or later, the Energy Center will close at 6:30pm

2. Reservations are required 24 hours in advance. Reservations can be made up to six days in advance.

- Reservations start on the hour or half hour with a 2 hour maximum visit per day. Child must be picked up at the 2 hour time limit.
- Please contact the Energy Center at (781)-337-0381 to cancel a reservation, cancellations must be made by the following times:

Monday through Friday

By 8:00am for the 8:30am – 1:00pm reservations

By 3:00pm for the 3:30pm – 7:30pm reservations

Saturday

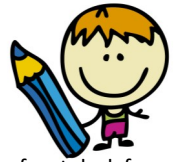
By 8:00am for the 8:30am – 2:00pm reservations

Sunday

By 9:30am for the 10am-1pm reservations

******If reservations are not cancelled by these times a \$5 fee per child will be charged.**

- **Reservation “No Shows” will be charged a \$5.00 fee per child.**
 - **After the 2 hour maximum allocated time, the late fee will be \$5.00 per child for each additional 15 minutes.**
 - Childcare service will be discontinued for those abusing the 2 hour maximum visit policy
3. Drop off Fees: Complimentary for members, Non members \$12 per child
4. Parents are to sign in upon arriving at the Energy Center, and sign out upon pickup
5. If your child is 7 years old please notify us if your child’s reservation is for downstairs or upstairs each time you make a reservation
6. Parents must remain in the club
7. Parents are required to bring their child’s personal supplies (diapers, wipes, etc) All personal items must be labeled.
8. No food or drink allowed. No “sippy” cups or snacks.
9. The staff is not responsible for diaper changing. Parents will be called to attend to their child.
10. Please do not bring in toys from home.
11. For health reasons, please do not bring sick children to the Energy Center
12. Children are released only to the parent that drops them off, unless the staff is notified ahead of time.



13. Pagers are available upon your request.

14. Hours of Operation change seasonally. Please check with the Energy Center front desk for updates.

15. The Energy Center is a drop off area for children only.

Energy Center Parent Handbook Programs

1. Parents must remain on the premises while their child is participating in an Energy Center program
2. Class tuition must be paid in full prior to the start of the class/session.
3. Make up classes are allowed only when the Energy Center cancels the class (snow, etc).
4. Switching of classes is not allowed after the 2nd week of the session.
5. **The Energy Center has a strict No Refund Policy.**
6. The Energy Center reserves the right to cancel class times/days due to low enrollment.
7. Children will be returned to the Energy Center Child Care after a program, upon request from parent. Reservations in the Child Care must be made.
8. Member complimentary passes cannot be used for Drop Off or The Attic.

Notice to Parents

The Energy Center is an exempt organization and therefore is not subject to licensing by the Department of Early Education and Care (“EEC”). As an exempt organization, EEC requires that the Energy Center notify parents/guardians of the following:

1. The Energy Center is not licensed by EEC or any other state agency.
2. The drop off program allows parents to use Weymouth Club facilities while their children (ages 8 weeks to 15 years) are supervised by Energy Center staff.
3. Parents/Guardians must remain on the premises the entire time their children are at the Energy Center.
4. Parents may drop off and pick up a child at any time the Energy Center is open and space is available, but children are not permitted to stay longer than 2 hours
5. The Energy Center is not responsible for the care or supervision of children beyond drop-off program closing time.
6. While using the drop-off program, parents/guardians remain responsible for basic care of their children and must perform care as needed.
7. Parents/Guardians must respond immediately to their children’s caretaking needs as they arise.
8. Parents/Guardians agree that if they fail to comply with these conditions of child care, the program will not be able to provide childcare services to their child.
