

All adult tennis programs are coordinated by the Tennis Manager. To inquire about or register for any of the following programs just call 781-682-5859.

Tennis Clinics

Tennis 101, 102 & 103 clinics are an hour and a half group lessons with a 6:1 student to pro ratio. Each class works on students' skills through instruction, drills & play scenarios. These classes are also a great way to meet other players at your skill level.

101: Open to adults with little or no play experience. Considered a beginners class. Rates available for 101 students to include a racquet. Class schedule: Mondays: 6:30pm to 8pm; Tuesdays: 10:30am to Noon; Wednesdays: 9am to 10:30am; Saturdays: 10:30am to Noon.

102: Suggested for players that are considered to be an NTRP rating of 2.5 and above. Ideal clinic for advanced beginners. Class schedule: Tuesdays: 9am to 10:30am or 6:30pm to 8pm; Thursdays 11am to 12:30pm; Saturdays: 10:30am to Noon.

103: Recommended for adults with an intermediate skill level that is playing at an NTRP rating of 3.0 and above. Class schedule: Thursdays: 6:30pm to 8pm; Saturdays: 10:30am to Noon.

3 & a Pro includes three players of compatible level and one pro. The first hour is devoted to instruction & drills. During the remaining half hour, each player plays with the pro and against the pro. Organize your own group or ask us to set one up for you. Groups are organized on weekdays from 7am to 3:30pm.

Instructional Play Group

An **IPG** works four players with one pro to develop all-around skills through instruction, drills & match play. Each group is comprised of players of a compatible skill level (2.0 & above). Groups can be set up at any time with the option for 1.5 hours and 2 hours of play. Non-members may participate in one eight-week session before becoming a club member.

Masters Clinic

Masters Clinic is open to the 55+ crowd. These clinics are scheduled on a weekly basis and require a class minimum of 4 players. Cardio Tennis is a fun group activity featuring drills to give players of all abilities a high energy cardio workout. This class gets your heart rate up in the beginning of the hour and keeps it up by combining heart pumping music with tennis drills and fast paced exercises. This class is available to players of all levels. Call the front desk 24 hours in advance of the class to get on the list (781-337-4600). Class minimum requirement (4 players). If class minimum is not met then use of the ball machine is offered to those on the reservation list. No "rain dates" allowed.

General Policies

The Weymouth Club has 13 indoor courts available from September through May. There are 3 outdoor clay courts and 10 indoor courts available from June through September. Our facility is open to the general public.

Court Fees: Indoor court fees = \$30 per hour non-prime time & \$36 per hour prime time. Junior walk-on fees are \$25 per hour.

Court Reservation: Members may reserve 7 days in advance.

Cancellation Policy: There is a 24-hour cancellation policy for courts and lessons. You will be charged the full price for the lesson or court if notice is not given at least 24 hours in advance.

Demo Racquets: A racquet demo costs \$5 and if purchasing, the fee goes towards the price of a new racquet. Demos may not be taken off the premises.

Ball Machine: \$7 an hour plus court fee. Pricing for unlimited use of the ball machine: Monthly = \$25; Yearly = \$100

Registration Policies

Registration: Students must register before first day of class/program.

Payment: Payment is due in full before taking the court for the lesson/program.

Prorate: If a class has begun, the fee will be prorated.

Refunds: No refunds for late arrival, early departure or withdrawal from class. If a student has a medical release, from a doctor, received at the time of withdrawal, a prorated refund will be given.

Carry Overs: There are absolutely no carry overs for missed classes from one session to another.

Make-ups: If a player cannot attend his/her class on a certain date, advance notice must be given in order to be permitted makeup time in another class. The Club will attempt to accommodate but does not guarantee requests for group program make-ups. Make-up requests depend on availability and existing class size.

Snow Policy: Weymouth Club will postpone/cancel classes due to developing weather conditions. If school is delayed or cancelled in the town of Weymouth:

- If before Noon, clinics & programs will be cancelled
- If after Noon, students & participants should call the Club two hours before the start of the program or clinic
- If Saturday or Sunday, students & participants should call the Club two hours before the start of the program or clinic
