



Frequently Asked Questions

Can my child register for more than one class?

You can after all the families have had an opportunity to register, if there are spots still available then you may register for a second class.

What is the discount for multiple children?

Discount for additional child is 10%.

Can I be the swim buddy for both my children?

No, there must be a 1:1 ratio of parent to child. If you have twins or more than one child, each will need a buddy.

If my child is potty trained, are they required to wear two layers?

Yes, new club protocol is if a child is 3 or under, they must wear two layers and the diaper should not be roomy. Currently the ONLY reusable diaper approved by Weymouth Club, Happy Knappy Diaper. Remember: two layers are required, a swimmers disposable diaper and the Happy Knappy reusable diaper.

Is there a lifeguard on duty during class?

Yes, SAFETY is our #1 PRIORITY. We always have lifeguards on duty while the pool is in use.

Is the pool heated?

The water temperature is kept at a very comfortable 85-86 degrees.

If I withdraw in the middle of the session, do I get a refund?

Once you sign-up, there are no refunds.

Why is the summer session a shorter than normal?

Given the timeline of state and local officials allowing us to open, it has taken some time to make sure we provide the best and safest experience for all, especially the youngest in our Ripples program. When we enter the fall season, we will be increasing our sessions to their normal length. We believe it is imperative that swimming is a vital life saving skill and should be continually practiced.

Why are the classes smaller than before?

In this interim "new normal" we have limited the number of swimmers to NINE per class. If regulations change, and ONLY if, our maximum number of students will max out at 12 in the future. We have made this decision in order to dedicate more time to each child embracing the Weymouth Club mission to deliver a higher quality lesson and more personal experience for families.

Has the curriculum changed?

Yes, it has been improved! We have taken what we see other swim programs are doing well and our Aquatics Director, Catherine Vaughn has taken her 30+ years' experience in this industry to develop a swim program that provides the best of the best.

Are masks required?

Yes, masks are required from the parking lot to the Ripples staging area on the pool deck. When you arrive to your seat you can take the mask off. Masks are required when in the building.

Can we shower after class?

Unfortunately for now, all locker room showers are closed. We understand the importance of changing your child's diaper, we will have the changing tables and deck cabanas available for you to change your child's diaper. Please dispose of properly.

Adults should arrive in their bathing suits and leave in their bathing suits. For the short-term, adults are *NOT* allowed to change or shower at the Club. We hope this will change in the next phase. Thank you for understanding, we recognize this is difficult and appreciate your participation in the summer Ripples program.
