



# Swim School Policies

Welcome to the WAVES Swim School. The following policies help us to provide a great experience for all our enrollees. These policies pertain to our Preschool and Youth levels.

- Payments are made on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month via EFT. You must have a credit card on file to be enrolled in the program. You may pay by check or cash each month by making an early payment between the 23<sup>rd</sup> and the last day of the month before, but you still need to have a credit card on file. The Weymouth Club reserves the right to withdraw a participant if your account goes in arrears.
- Your monthly tuition payment covers four lessons a month. There are times where there may be five lessons a month for certain days. If there is a holiday in that month, on a five week month we will not run lessons and the price will not be prorated and no makeup will be given. If a holiday falls on a four week month we will prorate the price of lessons that month. We will not be running lessons New Years Day, Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, July 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, August 29<sup>th</sup> – September 2<sup>nd</sup>, Halloween evening classes, Thanksgiving Day and the Friday after, December 23<sup>rd</sup> – December 25<sup>th</sup>, and New Years Eve.
- All children enrolled in the WAVES Swim School Preschool and Youth levels are entitled to one makeup lesson per month if they must miss a class. Here are our policies regarding missed classes.
  - o In order to receive a makeup lessons we must receive notice of their intended missed class by filling out our Swim School Absence Report Form online or letting the deck coordinator know in person. This form can be found at [www.weymouthclub.com/swimschoolforms](http://www.weymouthclub.com/swimschoolforms). We ask that if you know you need to cancel your child's attendance for a planned event that you let us know as far in advance as possible. This helps create makeup spots for other participants. If your child is sick you can cancel up to an hour before via the swim school form.
  - o Your one makeup lesson per month must be used within four weeks of the missed class. You may not add the makeup on after you have withdrawn from the program. It must be used within your last month enrolled.
  - o Makeups may not be rescheduled. There are no makeups for missed makeups.
  - o If the swim school has to cancel lessons due to weather or an issue with the pool you will be granted a makeup for the missed class and this will not impact your one make up lesson per month.

- To book a makeup lesson you must request the makeup online by filling out the Swim School Makeup Request form or speaking with the deck coordinator in person. The makeup request form can also be found at [www.weymouthclub.com/swimschoolforms](http://www.weymouthclub.com/swimschoolforms). We will respond to this form within 48 hours. All makeups will be booked through email or in person with the deck coordinator.
- You do have the ability to change your child's lesson day permanently at any time if your schedule changes. Please see the deck coordinator during your child's lessons or email [wavesswimschooladmin@weymouthclub.com](mailto:wavesswimschooladmin@weymouthclub.com).
- To withdraw from the program you must let us know in writing. Withdrawals must be received by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month prior. You can pick up a WAVES swim school withdrawal form from your deck coordinator or email [wavesswimschooladmin@weymouthclub.com](mailto:wavesswimschooladmin@weymouthclub.com).
- All children who are not potty trained must wear at least two layers of protection, to inhibit the spread of RWI (recreational water illness). Layer 1: Huggies® or Pampers® disposable swim diaper, Layer 2: plastic reusable swim diaper cover, Layer 3: swim suit. Parents can also choose to do two reusable diapers in lieu of the "disposable" diaper. For convenience, reusable diapers may be purchased from the Aquatics Pro Shop for \$10. Children must be potty trained for a minimum of 6 months before participating in just a swim suit.
- By signing this agreement, you agree to the policies outlined above. You have authorized Weymouth club to debit your monthly fee on the first of every month until written notice is given. Your account will be charged until all your payments have been made. I fully understand the terms of this agreement and promise to fulfill this commitment. I understand that it is my responsibility to review my monthly statements for accuracy of payments.
- I hereby represent to Weymouth club, its affiliated, shareholders, partners, officers, agents, servants, employees, and representatives (collectively Weymouth club) that I am in good physical condition and am able to safely participate in Weymouth club programming. I acknowledge that Weymouth club urges every participant to have a medical check-up before participating in any Weymouth club programs. I appreciate the danger of physical stress, strain, or injury and assume whatever risk is involved as a result of my use of the facilities, equipment, or services of the Weymouth club.
- I hereby release and hold Weymouth club harmless from and against any and all claims, liability, loss, damage, or injury sustained or incurred in connection with my use of the facilities, equipment, or services of the Weymouth club, and waive any and all claims against Weymouth club from any damage or liability resulting from or in the connection with such use, excepting such damage which may be caused by Weymouth club negligence.
- I hereby grant Weymouth club consent and permission to use my name, portrait, image, statements and comments and to copyright, use and publish the same in whole or in part, in any media for purposes relating to the business and activities of the Weymouth club, including trade or advertising.
- I hereby release and discharge Weymouth club from any claims or demands arising out of or in connection with such uses, including but not limited to any and all claims for libel or invasion of privacy.
- I understand and agree that the program is not a therapy program, nor should it substitute for medical treatment. This release, waiver and consent shall be binding upon me and my heirs, legal representatives and assigns.
